Syrah/Shiraz, 6th Sense, California Ripe dark plum with a hint of pepper and mocha with a nice spicy finish \$8.00 \$26

Malbec, Gascon, Mendoza, Argentina. Blackberry, blueberry, plum, dark cherry, and a hint of mocha \$8.50 \$28

Cabernet Sauvignon, Canyon Road, California Full-bodied, with rich flavors of berries and a soft earthiness \$7.50
